

15th Annual Research Symposium: The Rules

General Rules:

1. Poster session is open to all post-doctoral, graduate, and undergraduate students, and will have separate categories.
2. Undergraduate students may participate in the graduate poster category, but may only be registered in one category.
3. The oral session is open to graduate students and post docs only.
4. For graduate students and post docs presenting in both the oral and poster competitions the presented data must be different.
5. Presentations must be over research in the biological sciences.
6. Awards will be presented to top presenters in both oral and poster competitions and to top undergraduate poster presenters.
7. Presenters may place in only one competition: If a presenter places in two competitions they will be asked which prize they wish to be awarded.
8. Acceptance of abstracts will be limited due to time and space constraints.
9. Decisions over acceptance of abstracts will be made by the BMBGSA Symposium Committee and will take into consideration date of submission and content of the provided abstract.
10. Submission of abstracts opens August 3rd
11. Deadline for submission is August 31st
12. Applicants will be notified if their abstract was accepted by September 7th.
13. Judging requirements are provide upon request, but the Judges will remain anonymous until after the symposium.
14. All judges decisions are final.

Poster Session Rules:

1. Size: 36" (height) x 48" (width) maximum.
2. Posting of posters will begin at 8:45 AM on Sept. 19th
3. Posters must be posted before the poster session begins.
4. Presenters must be present during the session to be judged.
5. Poster printing can be arranged with the Biochemistry Department for \$25. PDF file of poster must be delivered to the BMB office no later than 5:00 PM September 7th, 2018.

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Oral Session Rules:

1. Presenters are limited to 15 minutes, including questions, and will not receive additional time.
2. Presentations must be provided to the coordinators by 12PM September the 17th in order to present.
3. Edited versions of the presentation may be presented to the coordinators before 8:00AM the day of the presentation.
4. Presenters whose Power Points that are not compatible with the provided computer will be contacted by September 18th.

Awards:

1. Award values are contingent upon funding and donations.
2. Award values will be determined no later than September 21th, 2018.
3. Awards will be distributed using the Oklahoma State University Bursar system.
